EMUNAH CHILDREN'S HOMES

Emunah's five Children's Residential Homes provide support and protection for Israeli children who cannot remain with their families due to unsafe home environments. Referred to Emunah by the government's social service agencies, children living in our residential homes are provided with care, warmth, love, and therapeutic treatments, as well as educational and social enrichment.

Each residential home is staffed by dedicated house parents, caregivers, teachers, and therapists who work together to create an environment of consistency and trust. The children receive personalized therapeutic care to help them heal from trauma, along with educational support, extracurricular enrichment, and opportunities to develop talents and interests. From art and music to sports and tutoring, every child is given the tools to succeed both emotionally and academically.

We strive to help these children build self-esteem, develop a sense of responsibility, and realize their full potential so they can contribute meaningfully to Israeli society and, one day, raise their own children in stable, loving homes. The impact of Emunah's work is evident in the achievements of our graduates, who go on to serve proudly in the IDF, volunteer in National Service, pursue academic studies. Through Emunah's Children's Residential Homes, we are changing the trajectory of individual children and shaping Israel's future.





EMUNAH SARAH HERZOG CHILDREN'S CENTER, AFULA

Located in Afula, the Emunah Sarah Herzog Children's Center is a vital residential and after-school facility serving 100 at-risk children and their families. For more than 75 years, the Center has been at the forefront of caring for Israel's most vulnerable youth providing protection, support, and healing for children facing abuse, neglect, trauma, and deep poverty.

Throughout its history, the Center has stood ready to meet the needs of every generation: from Holocaust survivors to immigrant children from North Africa, Ethiopia, the former Soviet Union, and struggling Israeli families from low socio-economic backgrounds. What unites them all is a need for hope and a place to call home.

The majority of our graduates, once vulnerable and without direction, have grown into strong, independent adults. They are now raising their own families with love and stability, breaking the intergenerational cycle of hardship.

At the Emunah Sarah Herzog Children's Center, our mission is to break the cycle of distress for at-risk children in Israel. With compassion, professional care, and unwavering support, we help each child heal from trauma, regain confidence, and envision a brighter future. Our ultimate goal is that the next generation, the children of those we help today, will grow up in secure, loving homes and never need the shelter of a children's residence.

HORSEBACK RIDING THERAPY

Building on Afula's commitment to healing and connection, the new Horseback Riding Therapy Program will offer consistent, weekly support to children in need of emotional recovery.

Ten children will participate in 90 minutes sessions with horses each week, providing a safe and therapeutic outlet for those who have experienced family dysfunction, neglect, and rejection. This regular interaction with the horses will help the children build trust, confidence, and emotional resilience, serving as a vital complement to the care they receive at the children's home.

- **Trust Building:** Develops emotional regulation and trust through a unique bond with the horse
- **Human-Animal Bond:** Horses are sensitive and responsive animals, and the bond formed between horse and rider can be deeply therapeutic, providing emotional support, companionship, and a sense of trust. This bond can be particularly beneficial for individuals with social or emotional challenges.
- **Emotional Regulation & Awareness:** Horses are sensitive to human emotions, providing feedback that can help riders develop greater self-awareness and learn to manage their emotions.
- **Confidence & Empowerment:** Boosts self-esteem by giving children a sense of control and achievement
- **Physical Growth:** Improves balance, coordination, and motor skills through riding
- **Social Connection:** Encourages peer interaction and teamwork in group sessions
- **Sense of Belonging:** Creates a supportive space where children feel seen, valued, and connected
- **Lasting Impact:** Fosters emotional and physical resilience with long-term benefits

THE SHABBAT ELEVATION PROJECT

Shabbat has the power to bring emotional stability, spirituality, and connection to the children of Afula. To make it truly meaningful, we must create an experience that speaks to their emotional needs.

The Shabbat Elevation Project builds a consistent and uplifting Shabbat experience through meals, singing, discussion, nice clothing, and meaningful traditions. When given the right motivation, the children respond.

On Rosh Chodesh, we promised shawarma to those who attended Shabbat morning prayers. All but three girls came, and they prayed beautifully. One boy later said, *"I came for the shawarma. I stayed because my heart wanted to pray."* Moments like this reflect the true potential of this project—to inspire from within.

- **Shabbat Clothing:** Provide children with dignified and festive attire to help them feel special and respected on Shabbat.
- **Spiritual & Emotional Incentives:** Use occasional treats, personalized rewards, or small gifts to encourage participation and create positive Shabbat associations.
- **Special Shabbat Programs:** Enrich the Shabbat experience through retreats, themed Shabbatot (e.g., Unity Shabbat, Shabbat for the Hostages), dorm-wide Kiddushim, and engaging activities like Torah discussions and reflective circles.
- **Guest Engagements:** Invite inspiring guests—educators, musicians, storytellers, and alumni—to enhance the atmosphere and provide meaningful interactions.
- **Hospitality Shabbatot:** Bring in families, staff, or volunteers to spend Shabbat with the children, offering a warm, home-like environment of care and connection.

ANIMAL THERAPY CENTER RENOVATION

Neve Landy seeks funding to refurbish its petting zoo, a central therapeutic resource that plays a vital role in the emotional healing and development of its children. For many of the boys and girls living at Neve Landy, the petting zoo is a place where they experience unconditional acceptance, where the gentle presence of animals offers comfort and calm in moments of stress. Through daily interactions, the children develop a sense of responsibility, compassion, and belonging, all of which are critical steps toward building trust and self-worth. These bonds with the animals help reduce anxiety, depression, and loneliness, while at the same time fostering confidence and resilience.

In addition to its therapeutic value, the petting zoo is an important educational environment. Here, children learn about nature, environmental preservation, and animal care in a hands-on, meaningful way. Working together to feed, groom, and nurture the animals fosters cooperation, patience, and teamwork. For many, this becomes a safe space where they can learn to give and receive love in a way that feels natural and non-threatening.

The refurbishment project will include critical renovations to the physical structure of the zoo, ensuring it is safe, secure, and welcoming. Enhancements will also be made to improve the quality of life for the animals, such as updated enclosures, improved feeding areas, and expanded shaded spaces. Additionally, the therapeutic areas will be redesigned to maximize opportunities for one-on-one and group activities between children and animals.

By investing in these much-needed upgrades, Neve Landy will be able to transform its petting zoo into an even more powerful therapeutic and educational resource. For children who have lost trust in the world around them, the zoo offers a pathway back to connection, hope, and emotional strength.

SOCIAL CLOWNING THERAPY

The Social Clowning Program is a groundbreaking therapeutic initiative, the only one of its kind operating within a children's home in Israel. For over ten years, professional therapeutic clowns have brought healing, joy, and emotional relief to the children of Emunah Afula through spontaneous, empathetic interactions that create a relaxed and supportive atmosphere. Twice a week, the clowns visit for six hours, engaging children of all ages with warmth and playfulness that encourages authentic expression and trust.

Using a distinctive set of tools—humor, fantasy, distraction, and gentle banter—the clowns help the children cope with emotional trauma, social integration, and daily challenges. By “playing the fool” and stepping out of the role of authority figures, the clowns become safe, approachable allies, enabling the children to open up in ways they might not with traditional caregivers. This unique dynamic gives Emunah Afula's clinical staff valuable insights and fosters opportunities for deeper therapeutic breakthroughs.

Fully integrated into Emunah Afula's professional team, the clowns work closely with psychologists, therapists, and social workers, serving as a vital catalyst for healing and resilience. The consistency of their visits provides stability, while their humor and play remind the children that joy and laughter can be trusted parts of their lives. Over the years, the program has become a beloved fixture at Emunah Afula, eagerly anticipated by children each week.

The program directly benefits all 80 children, ages 6–18, living in the home's residential and afterschool programs, boys and girls who have experienced severe abuse, neglect, and trauma and for whom Emunah Afula is often the first place they have ever felt truly safe.

EMUNAH ACHUZAT SARA CHILDREN'S HOME, B'NEI BRAK

Emunah Achuzat Sarah, located in B'nei Brak, Israel, is a warm, therapeutic residential home for over 100 at-risk children, ages 8–18. Referred by Israel's Welfare Department, these children come from deeply dysfunctional families and are removed from environments of neglect, abuse, and instability.

The children at Achuzat Sarah have endured severe trauma and many suffer from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), emotional and behavioral challenges, and significant learning difficulties.

Emunah's goal is to break the cycle of distress and give each child a real chance at a brighter future. Through a comprehensive, individualized therapeutic and educational program, each child receives the care, support, and tools they need to heal, grow, and thrive.

Emunah's Achuzat Sarah strives to nurture graduates with strong, healthy identities, empowering them to recognize their talents, build meaningful relationships, and maintain lasting family and social connections.

Our graduates are guided to lead independent, values-driven lives, rooted in the national-religious tradition. They are encouraged to give back through national service and to take on meaningful roles in society, becoming active, engaged members of their communities.



RECREATIONAL EQUIPMENT FOR TEENS' CLUB ROOM

Emunah Achuzat Sara is a therapeutic residential home for nearly 100 at-risk children, ages 8-18, who have been removed from their families by the welfare authorities. The home provides a stable, family-like environment rooted in Jewish values, helping children heal, grow, and develop a sense of belonging and self-confidence. For the older teens, aged 16-18, a dedicated club room was recently opened to provide a space for relaxation, peer interaction, and recreation.

To further enhance this space, we are seeking support to purchase gaming equipment, including 3 flat-screen TVs, 2 PlayStation 3 consoles, 4 PlayStation controllers, 2 docking stations for PlayStation, and 3 PlayStation games. These additions will help create a vibrant and engaging environment, giving the teens a healthy outlet for fun, connection, and stress relief as they work toward a brighter future.

This project will have a meaningful impact on the emotional, social, and personal development of the at-risk teens living at Achuzat Sara. For many of these youth who have experienced trauma and instability, the new gaming equipment will provide a safe and healthy outlet for stress relief and emotional expression.

The enhanced club room will serve as a positive, welcoming space where teens can relax, connect with peers, and enjoy age-appropriate activities. These shared experiences foster social bonding, teamwork, and a sense of belonging, which are key components in their healing journey.

By creating a vibrant environment rooted in care and connection, this initiative helps teens build self confidence, strengthen interpersonal skills, and take meaningful steps toward a brighter, more hopeful future.

MUSIC THERAPY LESSONS

Emunah Achuzat Sarah has introduced guitar instruction as a powerful therapeutic and creative tool for its children. With the guidance of a skilled guitar instructor, the children are given the opportunity to not only learn to play an instrument, but also to express themselves through the songs they choose and the music they create. Through this process, they begin to find their own voice which helps them release feelings of stress and anxiety. The calming effect of the guitar enables them to process their challenges in a healthy way, while also strengthening their self-esteem as they discover a talent they never imagined they could achieve.

This program empowers children with confidence, resilience, and a constructive outlet for emotional expression, giving them a sense of accomplishment and joy that carries into all areas of their lives.

THERAPY ROOM CONSTRUCTION

The children placed at Emunah Achuzat Sarah by Israel's social services and family courts arrive with complex challenges. These needs have only deepened in the aftermath of the October 7th attacks, leaving every child in urgent need of therapeutic intervention. Today, 75 children and teens live at Emunah Achuzat Sarah, alongside 20 at-risk children from the local Bnei Brak community who attend our Chacham Center daily. All require a wide range of therapeutic services, making the demand greater than ever before. To meet this critical need, we have launched the creation of a new Therapy Center with three treatment rooms by repurposing a former laundry building on campus. Located in a quiet area, the center ensures privacy and comfort, an environment encouraging even the most hesitant children to engage in therapy. This center represents healing and hope, empowering children who have endured trauma, and instability to begin their journey toward resilience and recovery.

EMUNAH NEVE LANDY CHILDREN'S VILLAGE, EVEN SHMUEL

The Emunah Neve Landy Children's Village in Even Shmuel provides a safe and loving home for 50 boys, ages 6–18, who have been removed from unsafe family environments and referred to us by welfare services. Many of these children have endured neglect, abuse, and instability, yet they arrive with incredible resilience and the potential to rebuild their lives.

Daily life at the village is structured to combine nurturing relationships with educational and therapeutic opportunities. Each child is placed in a family style group of 10–12 boys, supported by six dedicated staff members, a group coordinator, and a social worker. This intimate framework allows us to create a personalized care plan for every child—one that addresses his unique needs and challenges while building on his strengths and interests. From therapy sessions and educational tutoring to recreational activities and enrichment programs, each boy receives the tools he needs to progress, heal, and discover new possibilities for his future.

Beyond providing safety, the village instills self-confidence, responsibility, and hope for the future. Here, children learn not only to overcome their challenges, but also to envision and work toward brighter, more independent lives.

ADDITIONAL PERSONAL THERAPY

The challenging boys who reside at Neve Landy have individual therapeutic needs that are often not funded by regular therapeutic budgets or programs. Amongst these we include speech therapy, occupational therapy, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and didactic evaluation.

The cost of these treatments is \$115 - \$130 per hour. There are currently 28 children who are in need of an average series of 10 therapy sessions.

This support is vital because without it, these boys risk falling through the cracks. Standard resources simply don't cover the depth of their emotional, developmental, and learning needs. These targeted therapies provide the tools they need to overcome trauma, manage their behavior, and build the skills necessary to succeed. It's not just about treatment, it's about giving them a real chance at a better future.

STAYING IN TOUCH POST GRADUATION

The Staying in Touch program at Neve Landy plays a vital role in helping graduates transition into independent, meaningful lives by providing ongoing support once they leave the home's stable environment.

The program ensures regular contact with the graduates and their families, offering guidance tailored to each individual by long-serving staff who are familiar with their strengths and needs.

This support includes hired staff for 12 months and army service supplies for graduates. It also includes helping with military service, school, or Mechinot, and participating in meetings, ceremonies, and family events. In cases where family relationships are weak, coordinators ensure the boys have places to stay on weekends and holidays.

The program also provides career guidance, financial support for rent, and assistance with medical necessities ensuring graduates can thrive beyond Neve Landy.

I-LEAD: ARMY TRAINING PROGRAM

Teenage boys at Neve Landy will take part in a specialized program designed to help them grow into independent, responsible adults, with a strong focus on preparing for service in the IDF, a critical step toward integration into Israeli society and personal development.

In partnership with Acharai, a national youth movement that fosters leadership and social responsibility, 12 boys aged 16–18 will participate in a year-long program that includes weekly training sessions focused on physical fitness, mental resilience, leadership, and social skills.

They will receive individualized guidance throughout the IDF recruitment process and engage in enrichment activities such as outdoor expeditions, stretcher marches, navigation exercises, and meetings with IDF soldiers.

The program also includes visits to military bases, national sports competitions, and other meaningful experiences that break the routine, strengthen motivation, build teamwork, and instill a deep sense of pride and purpose.

I-13: BAR MITZVAH PROGRAM

This year, 14 boys at Emunah Neve Landy will celebrate their Bar Mitzvah. As their supportive family, we are committed to giving each of them a joyful, meaningful celebration that makes them feel valued and proud, regardless of their background.

The event takes place annually at our village with 200 guests, including residents, staff, and family members. Each boy receives new clothing and shoes, enjoy a festive meal with music and dancing, and be gifted a personalized photo album and canvas portrait. The celebration includes catering, decor, photography, a DJ, special gifts, and even a song recording by the boys themselves.

This unforgettable day is designed to honor each child and give them the love and dignity they deserve.

I-DRIVE: DRIVING LESSONS

When the boys in the Neve Landy Bayit Tova program reach age 17, they are given the opportunity to begin financing driving lessons. For these teenagers, driver's education represents a step toward independence, responsibility, and adulthood.

As part of Neve Landy's educational philosophy, each boy is required to contribute 50% of the cost, while the village covers the remaining amount. This balance encourages accountability and instills a sense of pride in their achievement. Many of the boys take on part time jobs in the afternoons or evenings, gaining valuable work experience along the way.

Dozens of boys have completed their lessons and obtained driver's licenses while living at Neve Landy. For them, the license is a symbol of maturity, freedom, and self-reliance, empowering them to move forward with greater confidence into the next stage of their lives.

REPLACEMENT OF WINDOWS, MOSQUITO NETS, AND SHUTTERS

Neve Landy, has provided a safe haven for over a thousand highly vulnerable and challenging boys. After more than 20 years of intensive use, the windows and shutters have significantly deteriorated, leaving them unsafe and visually unsuitable, creating an urgent need for replacement.

Replacing them is now imperative creating brighter, more welcoming spaces where children can feel safe and nurtured.

This upgrade will send a powerful message to the children that they are valued and cared for, reinforcing their sense of dignity, comfort, and self worth while contributing to a positive and supportive atmosphere throughout the village.

Your Investment Opportunity: \$180,000





PERGOLAS CONSTRUCTION

The boys at Neve Landy live in four residential homes on the main campus, each designed to offer a warm, supportive, and stable environment. Behind each home is a dedicated outdoor space intended to serve as a safe and inviting setting for recreation, relaxation, and social interaction. These areas are essential for the boys' physical and emotional well-being, providing a natural outlet for movement, connection with nature, and peer bonding outside of structured indoor routines. However, during the hot summer months, these outdoor spaces are fully exposed to the sun, making them uncomfortably hot and virtually unusable for much of the day. To address this, Neve Landy seeks to install a pergola (shade covering) in each home's outdoor area. With shaded areas in place, the boys will be able to comfortably spend time outside, enhancing their daily quality of life and supporting their overall development in a safe, nurturing environment.

Your Investment Opportunity: \$29,000



RECREATION FIELD ASTROTURF

Neve Landy has a large lawn behind the residential homes, which serves as recreation and relaxation for children and staff throughout the day. Over recent years the upkeep of the grass has become expensive and cumbersome, and Neve Landy is planning to replace the entire lawn with Astroturf, which in the long-term will be easier to maintain and save a significant amount of money on irrigation and constant repairs.

Replacing the lawn at Neve Landy with Astroturf is a significant upgrade that will greatly enhance the usability and sustainability of this central outdoor space. Installing Astroturf will provide a consistently safe, clean, and low-maintenance surface, ensuring the space remains accessible year-round while reducing long-term operational costs.

This investment supports both the well-being of the children and the financial health of the home.

EMUNAH NEVE MICHAEL CHILDREN'S VILLAGE, PARDES HANNA

The Neve Michael Children's Village is Israel's only multidisciplinary children's home, uniquely equipped with on site facilities including Family Homes, a 24-hour Emergency Crisis Center, and the country's first Teen Girls Crisis Center. Having programs located on campus allows for seamless daily routines, ensuring children receive consistent care and support throughout their day.

Many children arrive at Neve Michael feeling scared, isolated, and uncertain. To address these needs, the Village provides Family Homes, each led by a married couple and their biological children, living alongside a group of at risk children from the Village. These homes create a warm, family like atmosphere where children can experience stability, receive positive role models, and have their physical, emotional, therapeutic, and educational needs met. This environment enables children to develop trust, security, and a sense of belonging, foundations essential for healing and growth.

The Houseparents oversee morning routines, school preparation, meals, assist with homework, ensure participation in extracurricular activities and therapies, and support evening routines and bedtime. By fostering a consistent, caring environment, the Family Homes help children build life skills, resilience, and confidence, preparing them for a healthier, more independent future.



SPORTS THERAPY PROGRAM

For the children who in Neve Michael, sports therapy is more than physical exercise – it's a lifeline, a source of hope, and a path to healing.

Our all-encompassing program provides therapeutic benefits that reach far beyond the playing field. While education and traditional therapy are vital, the power of physical activity is just as essential for our children's well-being. It fuels their confidence, sharpens their focus, and nurtures essential skills like teamwork and perseverance.

For children who have faced more than their fair share of challenges, sports become a powerful tool for growth, resilience, and self-discovery.

Each sport offers a unique way for children to channel their energy, express themselves, and experience the joy of achievement.

PROJECT COMPONENTS

- **Basketball, Soccer, and Athletics:** Over 100 children participate in 21 hours of activities weekly, building camaraderie and physical strength through team sports.
- **Hand-to-Hand Combat:** For 30 children, the discipline and focus of martial arts training provide a safe space to learn self-control and boost self-confidence.
- **Bicycle Group:** 35 children ride together once a week, discovering freedom and empowerment with every turn of the pedal.
- **Track Group:** With 80 young athletes, the track group trains weekly and competes in eight races across the country, proudly wearing their running shoes and shirts as symbols of determination.

At Neve Michael, sports are not just a pastime, they are a pathway to a brighter future. For our children, each game, race, and practice session is a step toward overcoming their past and embracing the limitless possibilities ahead.

B'NEI MITZVAH PROGRAM

At Neve Michael Children's Village, the B'nei Mitzvah program marks more than a milestone; it's a meaningful step in each child's healing journey and connection to their Jewish heritage. Throughout the year, children participate in activities that enrich this experience, including:

- Day trips exploring the beauty and history of Israel
- Weekly lectures and workshops on the significance of becoming a Bar/Bat Mitzvah
- Provision of tefillin for Bar Mitzvah boys and candlesticks for Bat Mitzvah girls
- New clothing to ensure every child feels special on their day
- Support for a year-end celebration at Neve Michael, including a trip to the Kotel and dinner in Jerusalem

This program gives each child a chance to mark this milestone with dignity, pride, and hope for a bright future.

“SULAMOT” - THE ISRAEL PHILHARMONIC ORCHESTRA’S MUSIC THERAPY PROGRAM

Sulamot, meaning both “ladder” and “musical scale” in Hebrew, is a transformative music therapy program by the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra that supports at-risk children across Israel. At Neve Michael Children's Village, the program reaches 53 elementary and 20 high school students, guided by ten skilled musicians who help them learn, grow, and heal through the power of music.

More than just music education, Sulamot fosters emotional expression, resilience, and a renewed sense of hope. With three orchestras tailored to different age groups and skill levels, students develop their talents and share their progress through inspiring live performances. Each note they play becomes a step toward confidence, connection, and a brighter future.

SAILING THERAPY

One of the most unique and impactful therapeutic programs offered to the teenage boys at Neve Landy is sailing therapy, conducted at the Ashdod Harbor. This innovative program combines the healing power of the sea with structured, experiential therapy to help the boys build confidence, trust, and emotional resilience.

Through activities such as sailing, kayaking, and other sea based challenges, the boys learn to navigate both the water and their personal fears, gaining a sense of mastery, independence, and control. The program emphasizes teamwork, communication, and problem-solving, helping the boys understand the value of cooperation, mutual support, and persistence. For youth who have experienced trauma, instability, or behavioral difficulties, these skills are essential tools for emotional regulation, relationship building, and personal growth.

THE RETURN ON INVESTMENT:

Being out on the water provides a calming, restorative environment that encourages self-reflection, mindfulness, and responsibility. It offers a welcome break from the pressures and routines of daily life at the village, giving the boys the space to process their emotions in a natural and therapeutic setting. Over time, participants develop not only practical sailing skills but also a deeper sense of self-confidence, pride in their accomplishments, and the knowledge that they are capable of overcoming challenges both on the water and in life.

Sailing therapy at Neve Landy is more than just an outdoor activity, it is a transformative experience that empowers the boys to reconnect with themselves, build trust in others, and develop resilience that will carry them into adulthood. It is a program that teaches courage, patience, and perseverance while simultaneously providing joy, freedom, and a renewed sense of possibility.

TRAUMA THERAPY PROGRAM

In the wake of the war, Neve Michael's Trauma Therapy Program has become a critical lifeline for our children, many of whom already carry deep emotional scars. As they face the added trauma of war, fear of rockets, and the grief of lost loved ones, the need for compassionate, intensive care has never been greater, and timely intervention can make the difference between prolonged suffering and the beginning of healing. Each child's experience is unique, and without support, the weight of these compounded traumas can affect every aspect of their development, from emotional regulation to academic performance and social relationships.


Our children are grappling not only with painful memories of a turbulent childhood but also with the raw wounds of recent events. For many, this has triggered symptoms of PTSD, bringing anxiety, nightmares, flashbacks, and a pervasive sense of insecurity that affects their daily lives, their sense of safety, and their ability to trust others.

To meet this urgent need, we've expanded our Trauma Therapy Program, offering additional therapy hours to ensure no child is left to cope alone. Our dedicated therapists provide a safe, structured environment where children can express their fears, process their grief, and gradually build resilience and coping skills. Through individualized care and therapeutic interventions, each child is guided toward reclaiming a sense of stability and hope.

This program is about restoring hope, nurturing emotional recovery, and providing tools to rebuild trust in the world. We aim to guide these young souls back to a place where they can dream again equipping them with the confidence and strength to face life's challenges with courage.

The Trauma Therapy Program at Neve Michael promises our children they will not face this darkness alone; we walk with them every step of the way, offering steadfast support, professional guidance, and the reassurance that they are valued, heard, and never forgotten.

EMUNAH DAY CARE CENTERS

Emunah day care centers provide early childhood education and daily care in a warm, nurturing, and engaging Jewish environment. Each child is welcomed into a setting designed to stimulate curiosity, creativity, and social-emotional growth, while parents enjoy peace of mind knowing their children are safe, supported, and guided by highly trained staff. The centers focus not only on learning but also on emotional development, fostering confidence, resilience, and a sense of belonging from the earliest years.

Beyond standard childcare, Emunah's multi-purpose day care centers provide intensive support for at-risk children. Staff are trained to identify developmental, emotional, and behavioral concerns early, providing targeted interventions and guidance for both children and families. This proactive approach helps prevent long term challenges, empowers children to reach their potential, and equips families with the tools to support healthy growth at home.

Children also engage in activities that instill Jewish values and celebrate Israeli culture. From holiday celebrations to Torah stories and culturally meaningful projects, these experiences help children develop a strong sense of identity and ethical awareness.

In recognition of its exceptional contributions to early childhood education grounded in Israeli and Jewish values, Emunah was awarded the prestigious Israel Prize in 2008, an honor that highlights the organization's leadership and the lasting impact it has on generations of Israeli children.



15 DAY CARE CENTERS RENOVATIONS


Across Israel, Emunah's day care centers are lifelines for thousands of working families and safe havens for young children during some of the most critical years of their development. These centers foster early cognitive, emotional, and social growth, nurture emotional well being, and support families from every background with warmth and care. For many children, these centers are a first experience of community, and guidance, setting the foundation for lifelong learning and confidence.

Many of these centers, particularly those serving vulnerable communities, are in urgent need of renovation. Decades of continuous use, limited maintenance budgets, and growing enrollment have left facilities with worn infrastructure and outdated equipment. The spaces in which children spend their formative years should encourage curiosity, creativity, and joy, but too many centers today struggle to provide even the basics of a clean, safe, and welcoming environment.

This proposal outlines the renovation needs of 15 Emunah day care centers. Renovations will address a wide range of needs, including modernizing classrooms, enhancing playgrounds, improving safety and accessibility, updating kitchens and common areas, and creating spaces that inspire and engage both children and staff.

Supporting these renovations is an investment in Israel's future. By enhancing the environments where children learn and grow, donors help working parents maintain stability, empower educators to deliver high quality care, and provide children with the emotional and physical space to flourish. Each renovated center will be a place where children can explore, imagine, and thrive.

As a tribute to the generosity of our supporters, a plaque honoring the sponsorship will be placed at the renovated day care center, serving as a tangible reminder of the impact your contribution has on the lives of families across Israel.





At the **Kiryat Moshe** day care center, we are upgrading classrooms, play areas, the library, and the kitchen, along with repairs, painting, and improved lighting and ventilation—to create a safer, brighter, and more engaging environment for children and staff.

COST: \$52,000

At the **Pisgat Zeev** day care center, we are enhancing the sand play area with artificial turf and restocking toys and activities, creating a more engaging, safe, and child friendly environment for play and learning.

COST: \$12,000

At the **Rishon LeTzion** (Molcho) day care center, we are refreshing classrooms with new paint and equipment, renovating restrooms, installing curtains, replacing doors, and repainting the exterior, creating a safer, more comfortable, and inviting environment for children and families.

COST: \$65,000

At the **Modi'in** day care center, we are installing synthetic grass in all yards and repainting pergola structures, creating a safer, cleaner, and more inviting outdoor environment for children.

COST: \$38,000

At the **Petach Tikva** Torah V'Avodah day care center, we are repainting the center, completing interior and exterior renovations, replenishing toys and wall games, and upgrading playground equipment, creating a safer, more engaging, and welcoming environment for children and staff.

COST: \$28,000

At the **Kiryat Gat** day care center, we are upgrading play areas and kitchen facilities—creating a safer and more engaging environment for children and staff.

COST: \$36,000

At the **Netivot** Intervention and Therapy Center, we are upgrading therapy rooms, refreshing play materials, and improving the waiting area, creating a more comfortable and welcoming space for children and families.

COST: \$36,000

At the **Be'er Sheva** Multipurpose day care center, we are adding a music corner, library, therapeutic garden, and fresh paint, creating a brighter, more engaging space for children.

COST: \$12,000

The **Tiberias** day care center is seeking support to upgrade key areas, such as the outdoor play spaces, main entrance, kitchen, and essential facilities, to create a safer, more welcoming, and enriching environment for the children and families who rely on us.

COST: \$60,000

At the **Akko** Multipurpose day care center, we aim to enhance daily life by revitalizing the playground and outdoor spaces, upgrading the kitchen and staff facilities, renovating key areas of the building, and installing an industrial dishwasher, ensuring a safe, nurturing, and supportive environment for every child and caregiver.

COST: \$50,000

At the **Nahariya** day care center we are seeking support to renovate the kitchen, replace the entrance awning, update fire safety measures, refresh the interior with paint and lighting, and enhance the playground with equipment, turf repairs, and outdoor toys, creating a safer, brighter, and more joyful environment for children and families.

COST: \$42,500

The **Tiberias 200** day care center is seeking support to improve safety, functionality, and outdoor play by upgrading entrances, relocating laundry facilities, restoring play areas, and refreshing the building, creating a safe and welcoming environment for children and families.

COST: \$36,000

The **Tzfat** day care center is seeking support to upgrade the indoor play area, refresh the entrance and interior, and restore outdoor spaces, ensuring a safe, inviting, and engaging environment for children and families.

COST: \$30,000

At the **Akko** day care center, we are seeking support to address general repairs, repaint the main spaces and protected room, and resurface the stairwell enhancing safety, functionality, and creating a more welcoming environment for children and staff.

COST: \$22,000

At the **Hatzor HaGlilit** day care center, we are working to upgrade the play yards with synthetic grass and enhance the Gymboree equipment—creating safer, cleaner, and more engaging spaces for children’s play and development.

COST: \$18,000



HEBRON DAY CARE CENTER

The Emunah day care center in Hebron serves as a vital resource for families in Hebron, Kiryat Arba, and the surrounding areas. Currently, 31 children attend the center and 16 children are already registered for the coming year. As the neighborhood expands, the demand for high quality early childhood education is projected to grow, ensuring that more children benefit from a safe, nurturing, and supportive environment close to home.

The Emunah day care center is crucial to the vitality and continuity of the Jewish community in Hebron, allowing parents to work and provide for their families while ensuring that children receive compassionate care and a strong educational foundation.

The funds for this project are essential to sustaining the day care center and ensuring that every child receives the highest standard of care and education. Funds cover salaries for experienced caregivers, allowing us to maintain a low teacher-to-child ratio ensuring each child gets individualized attention. They also support the purchase of age appropriate educational materials, books, toys, and activities that foster learning and healthy development. Operational costs such as rent, utilities, and maintenance are critical to keeping the center safe, clean, and welcoming. This also covers nutritious meals, creative enrichment programs, and outdoor play opportunities that nurture physical, emotional, and social growth. Most importantly, it allows us to offer subsidies for vulnerable families, ensuring that financial limitations never stand in the way of giving children in Hebron a strong and nurturing start in life.

Cost: \$65,000

To ensure the continued success and stability of this unique program, we ask for an annual commitment for three years.



SCHOLARSHIPS FOR VULNERABLE FAMILIES

Emunah operates over 100 day care centers across Israel, providing essential services to vulnerable and low-income families, especially in communities near the borders.

TUITION STRUCTURE:

Tuition fees at government-supervised day care centers are regulated, with families paying on a sliding scale based on income. Working families with average incomes contribute over \$700 per month, while low-income families pay a minimum of approximately \$100.

IMPACT OF THE WAR:

The recent conflict has exacerbated financial difficulties for many families, particularly those in the south and far north, who are displaced, facing job losses, or serving in reserves. Hundreds of families have approached Emunah seeking assistance, as many can no longer meet even the minimum tuition fees required for day care. Without these payments, the government will not authorize a child's placement in day care, risking the loss of vital educational and social opportunities for hundreds of children.

CURRENT NEEDS:

Emunah is currently caring for 940 children across 15 day care centers in Southern Israel. It is estimated that 225 families—over a quarter of the children in our southern centers—are unable to afford even the minimum tuition. Emunah is committed to bridging this gap, ensuring stability and quality care for these children.

ANNUAL NEED:

225 children x \$100 monthly balance per child x 12 months

SPARKLING SMILES - DENTAL HYGIENE FOR CHILDREN

In many of Israel's underserved communities, children lack access to proper dental health education and resources. Poor oral hygiene in early childhood can cause pain, infection, malnutrition, and speech difficulties, impacting overall well being and academic success. Parents and caregivers often lack the knowledge and tools to manage their children's dental health from infancy. Sparkling Smiles for Emunah Children will provide dental hygiene education and resources to parents, caregivers, and staff at 50 Emunah day care centers, directly benefiting over 3,000 children (ages 3 months–3 years) and their families. A qualified dental hygienist will conduct engaging workshops focused on:

- Why baby teeth matter and how to prevent early decay
- Proper brushing techniques for infants and toddlers
- Nutrition for strong teeth and healthy growth
- Common dental concerns and practical solutions

Each child will also receive a dental hygiene kit with age-appropriate supplies, along with small rewards to encourage positive associations with dental care.

IMPACT

This initiative will give thousands of children the tools to grow up healthier and happier, while empowering parents and caregivers to instill lifelong habits that prevent pain and illness. Oral health is more than just a smile, it is directly tied to a child's overall well being, confidence, and ability to succeed in school and in life. By intervening early, we not only prevent needless suffering, but also reduce the long term burden of costly dental care and health complications later in life. Your support ensures that every child in Emunah's care can laugh, eat, speak, and grow without the limitations caused by untreated dental problems.

THERAPY & CRISIS CENTERS

Emunah Counseling Centers, located throughout the country, provide local communities with the tools and support they need to navigate the personal challenges of life. In addition to offering a wide range of psychological resources, the centers have expanded their focus to include those affected by the recent war, providing specialized care for individuals experiencing trauma symptoms and the lasting emotional impact of conflict.

Emunah's team of expert therapeutic professionals treats individuals with a broad spectrum of mental health issues while also empowering and strengthening parenting skills. By working closely with the entire family, they provide guidance, support, and practical strategies that help families build stronger, healthier relationships. Our centers provide counseling services at subsidized costs to individuals, couples, families, and children, ensuring that financial constraints do not prevent access to essential mental health care.

Emunah operates a Teenage Girls Crisis Center, a Children's Emergency Crisis Center, and 13 crisis intervention and therapy centers from the North to the South of Israel. At these centers, psychologists, social workers, and general staff carefully evaluate every person who arrives and design an individualized treatment program tailored to their unique needs. The goal of these programs is to foster self-sufficiency and resilience, equipping individuals and families with the tools to cope with life's challenges as confident, healthy, and capable members of society.





EXPANSION OF TRAUMA COUNSELING SERVICES

In light of the devastating terrorist attacks on October 7th and the ongoing conflict in Gaza and Northern Israel, Emunah's role in providing mental health support has become more critical than ever. The emotional and psychological toll on children, spouses of IDF reservists, bereaved families, and wounded individuals is profound, affecting all levels of society. Emunah's network of 13 counseling centers is actively responding to the escalating needs by offering trauma therapy and emotional counseling to those grappling with stress, evacuation, and bereavement.

Emunah's trauma counseling centers provide tens of thousands of subsidized therapy hours across Israel annually, operating in key locations such as Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Sderot, and Netivot. These centers offer therapy services at minimal cost to patients, often with co-pays under \$25. All therapists are highly qualified, specializing in areas such as family therapy, PTSD treatment, and psychotherapy.

Since October 7th, Emunah has been facing an unprecedented surge in demand for mental health services. Hundreds of thousands of individuals are expected to require emotional support, and Emunah's therapists are working tirelessly to provide care in-person and online. To meet the escalating need, Emunah plans to increase the number of therapists and therapy hours at each center, ensuring broader access to critical mental health services.

By contributing to this project, donors will directly support the emotional healing of countless individuals affected by the ongoing conflict, helping them rebuild resilience and strength in these challenging times.

FUNDING NEEDS

To address the growing demand for trauma counseling, Emunah is seeking \$450,000 to expand therapy services across its 13 centers. This funding will support the recruitment of 21 additional therapists and provide an estimated 430 additional monthly therapy hours.

DETAILED EXPANSION PLAN


- Centers Impacted: Beit Shemesh, Jerusalem, Modi'in, Nahariya (including Ma'alot), Netivot, Petach Tikva (including Elad and Rosh Haayin), Sderot, Rishon LeZion, and Tel Aviv.
- Staffing Increase: Additional 21 therapists will be hired across the centers.
- Therapy Hour Expansion: 430 additional therapy hours per month will be provided, totaling 5,160 extra hours annually.

COST BREAKDOWN BY CENTER:

- Sderot: 150 additional therapy hours monthly, \$144,000 annually.
- Netivot: 65 additional hours monthly, \$62,400 annually.
- Beit Shemesh: 50 additional hours monthly, \$48,000 annually.
- Other centers: Adding between 10-40 additional hours monthly, ranging from \$9,600 to \$33,600 annually per center.

At the high schools, educators create a stimulating and supportive environment where students are encouraged to explore their talents, develop critical thinking skills, and pursue excellence in all areas of study. Beyond academics, the schools emphasize character development, leadership, and community engagement, instilling values that guide students both in school and throughout their lives.

The schools are frequently awarded for both student accomplishments and the excellence of their educators. These accolades reflect the dedication, creativity, and professionalism of the staff, as well as the schools' commitment to nurturing confident, capable, and values-driven young women who are prepared to thrive in higher education, professional life, and as active contributors to their communities.



ALMA EMUNAH HIGH SCHOOL: DANCE STUDIO

Alma High School is renowned for integrating Torah values with the arts, empowering students to express their faith and emotions through art, music, and dance. Dance is an integral part of the curriculum, promoting discipline, self-expression, and collaboration. Classes are held in an improvised space that lacks proper flooring, mirrors, acoustics, ventilation, and safety features, limiting the potential of the program. The new dance studio will offer more advanced classes and expand the curriculum, provide a safe, inspiring environment for movement based therapy, community events, performances, and collaborations with local and international artists, and reflect Alma's commitment to excellence, creativity, and holistic education.

FACILITY FEATURES

- Sprung wooden dance floor for shock absorption and joint protection.
- Full-length mirrors and barres for professional training.
- Sound system with acoustic insulation.
- Modern lighting and ventilation.
- Storage space for costumes and equipment.

IMPACT

- Deepen student engagement, confidence, and emotional growth.
- Foster excellence in the arts and enhance Alma's national reputation.
- Provide a space for workshops, performances, and inter-school collaborations.
- Offer therapeutic benefits for students coping with stress, anxiety, or trauma.

This dance studio will be a sanctuary of joy and self-discovery. It will empower students to find their voice nurturing a generation of young women who are creative, confident, and inspired.

EMUNAH ELISHEVA HIGH SCHOOL: CONSTRUCTION OF OUTDOOR AMPHITHEATER

Emunah Ulpanit Elisheva High School, located in Pardes Chana, serves over 400 students from surrounding towns such as Zichron Yaakov, Harish, and Binyamina. The school provides a unique blend of modern religious education, offering courses in both sciences and arts alongside Torah study. It also supports special education classes and programs for girls at risk, many of whom live in the nearby Neve Michael Children's Village. Under the leadership of Dr. Yael Dukow, the school has seen significant growth and has become highly regarded within the religious Zionist community, with a substantial increase in enrollment over the past three years.

To accommodate the school's growth and enhance its arts, music, and drama programs, the construction of an outdoor covered amphitheater is essential. Currently, there is no space within the school where all students can gather for events, ceremonies, or performances. The amphitheater will provide a much-needed venue for these activities and create a central space for students to congregate and foster community. Additionally, the amphitheater will serve as an ideal platform for the students to showcase their talents in performing arts, allowing them to develop skills in acting, dance, and music, while also enhancing their sense of collaboration and community.



One of Emunah's flagship programs is its pre-army academy for young women, strengthening leadership, resilience, and critical thinking skills while instilling confidence, discipline, and a strong mindset. Additionally, Emunah places a strong emphasis on social activism and community leadership. Through targeted programs and initiatives, women are trained and supported to assume positions of influence in both the public and private sectors across Israel. By fostering professional development, advocacy skills, and civic engagement, Emunah ensures that women not only achieve personal success but also contribute meaningfully to society, driving positive change and expanding opportunities for others in their communities.





PRE-ARMY MECHINAT LAPIDOT

Lapidot-Emunah is a pre-military academy for religious girls that prepares its students for a rich spiritual life and to take responsibility in Zionist-social leadership roles, whether in the army or afterwards.

In recent years there has been a significant increase in the number of religious girls enlisting in the IDF. This trend is continuing, yet there are few programs that prepare these girls for meaningful military service and support them throughout their service.

The year between high school and military service is life-changing for young women looking for a challenge. Mechinat Lapidot-Emunah was established in 2014 to address this need and to become a home for religious girls who are motivated to enlist and also motivated to deepen and strengthen their religious, spiritual and Zionist identities.

Mechina life revolves around the group, which allows for sharing experiences and ideas and even taking an active part in leading the Mechina. Students are partners in developing core content and activities and spend more than one half day a week volunteering in a variety of fields in the community, with Holocaust survivors, special needs groups, etc. Additionally, hiking excursions strengthen the students' bond with the Land of Israel, and exposure to military frameworks ensures they find the most suitable roles for their aspirations and abilities.

The Mechina is in its 10th year of operation in full capacity (50 students) and a long wait-list. Over 400 graduates of the Mechina have served or are currently serving in the IDF in significant positions such as: elite intelligence units, major operations, the spokesperson's office, central command, combat training and others. Many of these graduates are now officers and have signed on as career soldiers.

This year-long prestigious program is a flagship opportunity to influence Israel's next generation of leaders.

COMPREHENSIVE OVERHAUL

Located in the picturesque settlement of Mitzpe Dani, overlooking the Judean Hills, the Mechina's physical infrastructure remains inadequate. The living conditions on campus are basic and insufficient, limiting the potential for growth, comfort, and an optimal learning environment.
